

Facilities

Web press comes with an array of tools created to help the user build his site.

Some of the facilities are listed bellow.

- Site manager: helps the user to manage the general data about his site.
- File manager: the user can upload, download, delete, edit the files that compose his site.
- My templates: allows the user to manage his templates and also to choose a template from the library.
- **Dynamic modules**: there are three default dynamic that can be inserted into the user's web pages: GuestBook module, Visitor counter module and Site statistics module.

Web press is an easy to use tool for building presentation internet sites. It comes with a variety of templates to choose from. A web site built with webxpress can contain multiple templates which can also be modified by the user.

How can I use web press in my system?

Web press has been conceived to be installed and run as a stand-alone website and also as a module. It can be easily integrated into your existing system, providing you users with an essential tool for quickly building a website. The integration process is fairly easy and is assisted by us.

What technologies uses web press?

Web press has been built using PHP web programming language and MySQL database engine.

Well, how can I build my website using web%press?

This is done in a very simple way. You must first choose a title and description for his site. Then, you must choose a web page template for your site. There is a great number of templates available on the system. If no template fits your requirements, you can simply modify an existing template or create a new one.

The last step of the process consists in adjusting some additional settings (like choosing one or more dynamic modules), testing and releasing your site.

What other facilities does web press provide?

The web press site builder (either full or module installation) can be complemented with additional modules:

1. DNS manager: used to create sub-domains;

2. merchant modules: used to manage billing;

3. email manager: used to automatically create mail accounts for your users;

4. site promoting: used to promoted your user's new sites;

5. live support (by phone or email);
